



HUNTER DIVISION Point Tabulations (GR1131 & GR1132)

UNITED STATES EQUESTRIAN FEDERATION – ALL THINGS EQUESTRIAN

AWARDS BASED ON POINTS

Point Tabulation:

In “A”, “B” or “C” rated hunter sections, points are determined by adding one point for each entry to the base points listed on the increment chart below.

Base points per competition rating:

For the purpose of calculating points, the number of entries for all classes in a hunter section is determined by the number of entries in the first performance class of the section. Points are calculated by adding the point value on the increment chart to the number of entries in the first performance class of the section. For example, in a “C” rated section with 5 entries in the first class, the value of a third place ribbon will be 9 points. This is calculated by adding 4 points from the 3rd place ribbon in the “C” rated chart to 5, which is the number of entries in the first class. If the first performance class of the hunter section has fewer than three entries that show and place, points will be determined by the number of entries in the second performance class of the section.

To determine points for Zone Awards, ribbons won in any “A” or “B” rated section will receive base points plus number of entries based on the “B” point chart.

Championship and Reserve Championship:

- Division champions will be awarded 2.0 times the total 1st place point value of the first class in that section.
- Division reserve champions will be awarded 1.2 times the total 1st place value of the first class in that section.

AWARDS BASED ON MONEY WON

Point Tabulation:

Money won will be counted for points based on a scale of one point for every dollar earned. Money won in the International Hunter Derby and Hunter Classics will also be awarded as one point for every dollar won.

National Horse of the Year Awards based on money will be awarded in the following categories:

Green Conformation Hunter
 Regular Conformation Hunter
 1st Year Green Hunter
 2nd Year Green Hunter

High Performance Working Hunter
 Performance Working Hunter 3'6"
 Performance Working Hunter 3'3"

Championship and Reserve Championship:

- Division champions for First and Second Year Green Hunter, High Performance Working Hunter, Performance Working Hunter, Green Conformation Hunter, and Regular Conformation Hunter will be awarded points equal to 10% of the total prize money for each section towards National Horse of the Year awards.
- Reserve Champions will be awarded points equal to the amount of 5% of the total prize money for each section.

HUNTER CLASSICS

Bonus points will be awarded toward Horse of the Year Awards in the horse's respective section. The bonus points are as follows:

USHJA NATIONAL HUNTER DERBY

Zone bonus points will be awarded to each horse's respective hunter section as declared at time of entry. A horse may be declared in only one of the following sections at the competition: Pre-Green, Performance Hunter 3'3", Children's, Pony, Adult Amateur or Amateur Owner 3'3". Only Juniors or Amateurs may declare for the applicable Children's, Pony, Adult Amateur or Amateur Owner 3'3" section. National bonus points will not be awarded. At "AA" or "A" rated competitions, zone bonus points will be awarded as follows: 1st -100, 2nd-80, 3rd-70, 4th-60, 5th-50, 6th-40, 7th-30 and 8th-20. At "B" or "C" rated competitions, zone bonus points will be awarded as follows: 1st-75, 2nd-65, 3rd-55, 4th-45, 5th-35, 6th-25, 7th-20, 8th-15.

USHJA INTERNATIONAL HUNTER DERBY

Points and money won in the USHJA International Hunter Derby will only be awarded towards a declared Hunter section for HOTY awards if a horse competes in the declared section a minimum of 5

times during the competition year. National points/money won will be awarded in each horse's respective hunter section as declared at the time of entry. Horses ridden by junior and amateur riders will receive points in the respective Junior or Amateur Hunter section.

HUNTER BREEDING

- Hunter Breeding Awards are offered at the Zone and National Level for Hunter Breeding Yearling, Hunter Breeding Two-Year Old, and Hunter Breeding Three-Year Old.
- Classes will only accumulate Horse of the Year Points from January 1 to November 30 of the current show year (see GR1115).
- Federation Horse of the Year Points will be awarded in the Best Young Horse class regardless of the number of entries.
- Classes with combined aged groups do not count toward the Horse of the Year Awards. Exception: Best Young Horse class.

(*) If a horse which competes in a qualifying class with less than three entries becomes Best Young Horse or Reserve Best Young Horse at the competition, they will receive full points for the qualifying class (i.e. 5 pts. for 1st, 3 pts. for 2nd).

Championship points are based on the total number of horses in the rated classes of the Hunter Breeding Division at the competition:

PONY HUNTER BREEDING

- Pony Hunter Breeding Awards are offered at the Zone Level for Pony Hunter Breeding Yearling, Pony Hunter Breeding Two-Year Old, and Pony Hunter Breeding Three-Year Old.
- Classes will only accumulate Horse of the Year Points from January 1 to November 30 of the current show year (see GR1115).
- Points will be awarded in the Best Young Horse class regardless of the number of entries.
- Classes with combined aged groups do not count toward the Horse of the Year Awards. Exception: Best Young Horse class. See Also GR1113.

Championship points are based on the total number of ponies in the rated classes of the Pony Breeding Division at the competition:
