Recognized Stewards are governed by the provision of the current USHJA and NCHJA Rule Book. The Steward is responsible for a complete knowledge of the regulations, duties, and authority that pertain to his office. He is reminded that he has no authority in connection with the management or judging of the show. He shall keep himself available to judges, exhibitors, and the show committee to clarify the application of rules of the Association and to investigate any situation where the rules of the Association are involved. It is his duty to observe and report immediately any instance of a violation of the rules to the show committee and make recommendations for the improvement of the show. Violations and recommendations must be included in this report.

It is obvious that, however complete rules may be, they never can cover all possible situations that may arise. If a matter cannot be solved by interpreting the rules to the letter, the solution to be adopted by those responsible should lie in a principle that follows as nearly as possible the spirit of the rules.

Failure of a Steward to attend a show or to perform his duties constitutes cause for disciplinary action.

I. GENERAL
