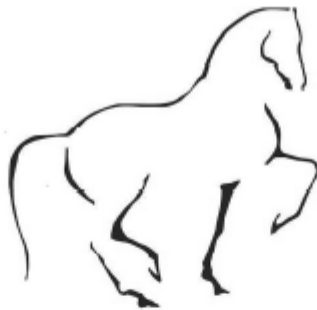

Did you know about The Tad Coffin Zone 3 Junior Equitation Finals?

2008 Qualifying Criteria:

Open to junior members of the USHJA who reside in Zone III. Qualifying shall be by winning any of the Zone III state equitation medals or by winning the USEF medal, ASPCA Maclay, or WIHS medal classes held in Zone III. Classes shall be divided by height. There will be two height sections; three feet (3') and three feet, six inches (3'6"). The three foot section is limited to riders who have not competed three or more times in any division or class at 3'6" or higher. The course for the finals shall consist of at least ten jumping efforts with at least one combination and two changes of direction. Classes may be split at the discretion of the committee.

Bridging the Gap

The NCHJA was established in 1973 by a group of individuals who set as their purposes of incorporation "To serve and promote the best interests of Recognized Shows and of the Exhibitors who participate in them". It also included Combined Training Events and Dressage competitions in that first sentence. Our industry has grown and flourished and changed much since that group sat down to incorporate. Combined Training and Dressage have their own associations in NC and do not look to the NCHJA for guidance any longer. They went on to say that the purpose was to "promote the interest of the industry and to educate and inform the public".

We have been pretty good stewards for the purposes of the corporation with the exception of one area, we have let our organization slip into two factions: the A group and the C group. We do not need, nor could we govern two associations for these two factions of our membership. They are the same; they overlap (a lot less than they did back in 1973 but they still overlap).

We, as responsible members, of the association need to decide to make the NCHJA as positive and as strong as it can become. We have plenty of people who are members of the NCHJA and reside in NC who are strong leaders in the USEF and USHJA governing. We have members who are respected judges, stewards, trainers, riders, and horse show managers from NC who work and compete all over the country. We need to take these resources and use them to our advantage. These people did not out grow us, we decided that they were not interested in us and let them slip away. We need to get them back! We need to keep the association growing from the bottom up and not let either faction outgrow the Association.

It should be as much of an honor to win a year end award from the NCHJA as it is the zone, or the HOTY. We have some of the most competitive divisions in both our C and our A shows as there are anywhere in the country. We need to all join forces and let the rest of the country know that we in NC are a force to be reckoned with at all levels.

When our annual banquet comes around in Pinehurst in January, come and participate in the learning process, in the celebration of what our industry has grown into. Come and pick up your award or applaud those who are there to pick up theirs. Stand up and be recognized for your achievements or stand beside someone who wants to be standing up there in the future.

We need mentors for up and coming trainers, judges, stewards, and horse show managers as well as riders. We do not need for the membership to stand on two sides of the fence and look at one another like we are not all working for the same goal. We are ALL working towards better horse shows and better judging and better stewarding and better horsemanship!

We have members who have ridden in the Olympics, who have won ribbons in the Medal, Maclay and USET finals, who have won at indoors, who have judged, managed and stewarded and trained at the most prestigious horse shows in the country and we should use that fact to learn one thing and one thing only: It is possible for someone living in NC to go as far as they want in this industry.

How do you reach the goals you set for yourself whether they are as high as the Olympics or to ride in the children's or adult hunter division at a C show? You look around at people who have reached their goals and ask questions and advice and use them as mentors.

If you are one of the lucky ones who have gone on and reached your goals, you do not look down ... you look back and see what you can do to help bring along someone else.

This is a goal oriented business and our goal must be to try to bridge the gap and begin mentoring people in our own back yards.

If you live and show in NC at recognized horse shows (whether they are A or C) or make your living showing, judging stewarding, training at recognized horse shows in NC you owe it to your community and to this association to come and join the governing and the festivities in Pinehurst and to ask not only what your association can do for you but what you can do for your association!

A Natural Horsemanship Event is coming to North Carolina!

Pat and Linda Parelli are coming to the Senator Bob Martin Easter Agricultural Center in Williamston, NC on February 9 and 10, 2008 for a two day Natural Horsemanship demonstration session. If you are not familiar with the Parelli method of Natural Horsemanship, it focuses on training people to learn how to recognize and understand a horse's personality and how to establish a relationship with that horse in order to achieve desired results. The Parelli's describe their methods as being more than just about the horse, though. They say their method also dips into the personal side of things.....you learn about yourself, you learn about communication, about leadership, about truthfulness, and consequences and responsibility. The horse becomes the animal that tell you the truth about yourself in all these categories. The program and your horse give you a living model so you can practice and become fluent in your abilities in all relationships, not just the horse relationship. What people find most interesting about Natural Horsemanship is what you can accomplish with your horse.

The Parelli's demonstrate this in their two day session by taking a local "problem" horse and transforming the horse into one who is not made to do things but one who wants to do things. Local students are also invited to participate in the demonstration. If you are interested in Natural Horsemanship, you can check out the website www.parelli.com for a description of the demonstration program and more background on what their brand of Natural Horsemanship is all about.

RULE CHANGES - EFFECTIVE AS OF DECEMBER 1, 2007.

PART II - REGULATIONS RULE III - OFFICIALS AND SHOW MANAGEMENT

The duties of show officials shall be the same as those found in the current USEF Rule Book where applicable. Show management should be especially cognizant of the following duties:

9. File a copy of the horse show's liability insurance binder or certificate of insurance with NCHJA two weeks prior to the show. If a horse show's management is holding several shows, one copy is sufficient. Failure to do so will result in the show being fined \$50.00. If the fine is not paid, it will be added to the amount of dues for the ensuing year and future competition dates will not be awarded until both penalty and dues have been paid.
112. Any NCHJA/USEF recognized horse show held in the state of North Carolina must offer the E.J. Haun Memorial Medal Class, the NCHJA Equitation on Ponies Class, the NCHJA Children's Medal Class, and the Bryan Jones Memorial Medal Class. The E.J. Haun Memorial Medal Class, the NCHJA Equitation on Ponies Class, the NCHJA Children's Medal Class, and the Bryan Jones Memorial Medal Class may only be offered at NCHJA/USEF recognized shows.
- Any NCHJA "C" horse show held in the state of North Carolina must offer the NCHJA Children's Equitation Class, the NCHJA Adult Equitation Class, and the NCHJA Pony Equitation Class. The NCHJA Children's Equitation Class, the NCHJA Adult Equitation Class, and the NCHJA Pony Equitation Class may only be offered at NCHJA "C" shows.

RULE V - STEWARDS

Add at the end of Rule V: A member of the Board of Directors may serve as a steward for a NCHJA "C" show.

RULE VII - EQUITATION DIVISION RULE XII - NCHJA CHILDREN'S MEDAL CLASS USEF/NCHJA RATED COMPETITIONS ONLY PART I - CLASS SPECIFICATIONS

NCHJA Children's Medal Class - Open to Junior members of NCHJA. Must be a member before entering the Class. To be shown over a hunter type course of not less than eight fences 3' in height and one-third of the obstacles must be oxers. The course must include at least one change of lead and two of the following: bending line, roll-back turn, or long approach to a single jump. Only one rider per horse. Four competitors to fill the class. Three competitors must complete the course. 25% or a minimum of three, whichever is greater, shall be invited to show both ways of the ring; being judged on seat, hands, guidance, and control of the mount. The flat phase of selected contestants shall count 50%. Judges may ask contestants to perform USEF tests 1-19. Course must be approved by the judge and steward.

Contestants in the NCHJA Children's Medal Class are not eligible for the NCHJA Equitation on Ponies Class or the E.J. Haun Memorial Medal Class at the same show.

PART II - NCHJA CHILDREN'S MEDAL FINALS SPECIFICATIONS

Section 1. NCHJA CHILDREN'S MEDAL FINALS - The top 15 Junior members who have accumulated points from June 1 through May 31 in the NCHJA Children's Medal Class and who choose to compete in the Finals will be eligible for the Finals. To be shown over a hunter type course of not less than eight fences 3' in height including two combinations, two oxers, and two changes of direction. Any additional fences, not to exceed four, shall require one additional oxer. All riders are required to show at a walk, trot, and canter both ways of the ring. The flat phase shall count 50%. Two or more tests (USEF 1- 19) of at least the top four contestants are required. Class to be judged on seat, hands, guidance, and control of the mount throughout. Only one rider per horse. The winner of the NCHJA Chil-

dren's Medal Finals shall receive a medal. Riders competing in the NCHJA Children's Medal Finals cannot enter the E.J. Haun Memorial Medal Finals or the NCHJA Equitation on Ponies Finals in the same year.

Section 2. NAMES AND ADDRESSES of previous winners should be made available to show management for printing in the Annual Show's prize list and program. One page of the prize list and program should be devoted to the class specifications and the previous winners.

Section 3. COMPETITORS - The top 15 Junior members who have accumulated points from June 1 through May 31 in the NCHJA Children's Medal Class and who choose to compete in the Finals will be asked to compete in the Finals. If anyone in the top 15 chooses not to compete in the Finals, NCHJA will ask additional competitors, based on points earned, to compete in the Finals with the goal being 15 competitors in the Finals.

RULE XVIII - ADULT AMATEUR HUNTER

Section 1. To be ridden by an amateur in possession of a valid amateur card. A rider in the Adult Amateur Division is not eligible to compete in any class where fence heights exceed 3'3" with the exception of the Children's/Adult Jumper Division. Course shall consist of no less than eight fences. Fence height shall be 3'; spreads not to exceed height of fence. If the Adult Amateur division is split two ways, it must be split from 18 to 35 and from 36 and over. If split three ways, it must be split from 18 to 35, 36 to 46, and 47 and over. To be judged on performance, manners, way of going, and soundness. Suitability of an Adult Amateur Hunter to be stressed. Horses to be jogged in accordance with USEF Rule HU124.

RULE XXI - PRE-GREEN WORKING HUNTER

Section 1. Open to horses in their first or second year of showing over fences 3' or higher at USEF regular member competitions or Combined Training Events. A first year pre-green horse must jump 3' and a second year pregreen horse must jump 3'3". A horse cannot show in the Green Hunter Division or show over fences 3'6" or higher and still be eligible for Pre-Green. Reinstatement rules are the same as for Green Hunters. If a horse has been reinstated from first year green, it must show as a second year pre-green horse. (Exception: Horses that have shown over 3' as a Three Year-Old are eligible as first year pre-green the following year that they show. Pre-Green Hunters are not required to jog for soundness.

RULE XXII - PRE-CHILDREN'S/ADULT HUNTER ***NCHJA "C" SHOWS ONLY***

To be shown by a junior or amateur in possession of a valid amateur card. Horse/pony/rider combination who have shown over fences at an NCHJA or USEF recognized show in a rated division or class, or in an unrated division or class with fence heights 3'6" or higher, are not eligible for Pre-Children's/Adult Hunter Division.

Horse/pony/rider combination can not cross enter into divisions or classes where fence heights exceed 2'6" at the same show. Ponies may not cross enter into the Children's Pony Division or the rated Regular Pony Hunter Division. Ponies shown in the Children's Hunter Pony section may not be shown by an adult at the same competition. Riders showing in the Children's Pony or Regular Pony Divisions may not cross enter into the Pre-Children's/Adult Hunter Division at the same show.

To be judged on performance, manners, way of going, and soundness. Suitability of a PreChildren's/Adult mount to be stressed. Fence heights to be 2'6". Distances between fences will be set using 12' multiples.
